Why Sleep Testing is Important

Getting adequate sleep is essential to proper health and well being. If an adult does not get 7-8 hours of sleep on a regular basis, there is increased risk for a variety of life-threatening conditions including cancer, heart disease, diabetes, accidents and obesity.

Symptoms of sleep problems may include one or more of the following: pauses in breathing during sleep, loud snoring; excessive drowsiness while engaged in daily activities or experiencing unrefreshing sleep; having difficulty sleeping three nights a week or more; tingling or unpleasant sensations in the legs when trying to sleep; and frequent interruptions to sleep.

Those experiencing sleep issues should consult with their healthcare provider right away to protect themselves from the adverse affects of sleep problems. Most sleep problems can be successfully treated or controlled with medication, light therapy, continuous positive airway pressure devices and scheduled naps. Yet, sleep diagnostics are essential to proper diagnosis and effective treatment.

Individuals have a choice of sleep testing facilities and should talk with their provider about Sleep EZ Diagnostic Center.

What Sets Sleep EZ Apart?
